Attwood Elementary	Lansing/ Ingham	3rd	Courtyard Project	Purchase plastic edging, seeds and bushes to clean up and beautify the school courtyard.
Central Elementary	Okemos/ Ingham	2nd	Shade Garden and Monarch Butterflies	Purchase two Monarch Raising Kits and shade plants for new shade garden.
E.E. Knight Elementary	Elsie/ Clinton	2nd & 3rd	Save A Tree-Recycle Paper	Purchase #2, 23 gallon blue recycle bins and #25, 28 quart blue recycle bins for their school to start a recycle program.
Elmwood Elementary	Lansing/ Ingham	4th	Elmwood's Michigan Habitat Site	Purchase a gate for their garden and native Michigan plants.
Fern Persons Elementary	Olivet/ Eaton	3rd	Operation Saving Birds	Purchase 4 bird feeders, bird seed, posts, and 3 bird ID books to learn about birds.
Gateway North Elementary School	St. Johns Clinton	4th	Worms That Recycle	Purchase worms, spray bottles, Rubbermaid containers, dry wall tape, 3-prong garden tools and dirt to learn how worms recycle.
Heritage Elementary	Stockbridge/ Ingham	5th	Operation Restoration	Purchase hammers, nails, shovels, rakes, trowels, measuring tape, lumber, lag screws, washers and gloves to restore an outdoor classroom so they can learn about nature.
Marble Elementary	E. Lansing/ Ingham	1st	Garden Creatures "Things that Fly"	Purchase clay, gems, tiles, glazes & metal rods to make garden creatures, to learn about things that fly.
Murphy Elementary	Haslett/ Ingham	4th/ Resource Room	Courtyard Community	Purchase a fishpond, pump, mulch, rocks, plants & flowers for school courtyard.
Neff Elementary	Grand Ledge/ Eaton	4th	Neff Welcome Garden	Purchase supplies to build gardens around their school: landscape timbers, shepherd's crook, bird feeders, daylilies, pampas grass, wood chips, bird seed, landscape plastic, & annuals.
North Aurelius Elementary	Mason	4th	Operation Eyrie: Extreme Makeover--Cage Improvements	To perform a service learning project by purchasing shovels, work gloves, flower bulbs and materials to make signs, to make-over the Eagle Exhibit at Potter Park Zoo.
Red Cedar Elementary	E. Lansing/ Ingham	1st	"Home Tweet Home"	To maintain a permanent quiet garden by purchasing bird food, plants and bulbs, tools, bench butterfly kit, ladybug lodge, bird feeders, 20 journals, bird sounds tape, and a watering can.
Scott Elementary	DeWitt/ Clinton	3rd	Operation Plant	Purchase a weeping cherry tree, barberry bushes (2), a butterfly bush, mulch, a birdfeeder and bulbs to beautify the entrance to their school.
Wainwright Elementary	Lansing/ Ingham	1st, 2nd, & 3rd	Helping the Earth	Purchase books and 12 pkgs. of t-shirts to help learn about pollution and recycling and to help educate the public.
Windemere View Elementary	Lansing/ Ingham	Kindergarten	School Flower Garden	Purchase cement, rocks, forms & glass marbles to make stepping stones for the school garden.
